Compost /Yard Waste*

*Applicable to customers with collection services.

- Place yard waste in biodegradable, brown yard waste sacks or in 30-gallon, plastic cans clearly marked with "Yard Waste" or "X" and placed facing the street.
- Branches must be less than 2 inches in diameter, less than 4 feet in length and tied in bundles.
- Yard waste must weigh less than 50 lbs.

Trash

Trash is collected in plastic garbage bags or garbage cans weighing no more than 50 lbs. when full (No 55 gallon barrels)

NOT Accepted in Trash:


